# SLATE OF CANDIDATES FOR

## DIETRICH SCHOOL NOMINATING COMMITTEE

The following slate of candidates for the 2015-2016 Dietrich School Nominating Committee was prepared by the Dietrich School Council at its April 17, 2015 meeting. The faculty members listed have indicated their willingness to serve on the Nominating Committee for a term of one year if elected.
